In response to the GFWC call for a Day of Service project focusing on food insecurity, eight other clubwomen joined them in the food packing project. Food donations were accepted at the September general meeting, and monetary donations from the Club and members totaled \$1,000.

Environment CSP has taken a jumpstart on projects, beginning with our first quarter Manatee Ave cleanup in our collaboration with FDOT Adopt-a-Highway. Seven members and one spouse picked up an estimated 80 lbs. of trash in the two-mile stretch!



October	
Easy to transplant from seedling	Arugula, Beets, Broccoli, Brussels sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Chinese cabbage, Collards, Eggplant, Endive, Kale, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Peppers, Strawberry, Sugarcane, Swiss chard, Tomatillo, Tomatoes, and tropical Spinaches
Transplant carefully from seedling	Amaranth, Calabaza, Celery, long Squash, Luffa, Mustard, Pineapple, Potatoes, Seminole pumpkin, and Spinach.
Sow seed directly	Beans (bush, lima, pole), Carrots, Corn, Cucumbers, Okra, Onions (bulbing, bunching), Peas (southern), Radish, Squashes, and Turnips.
